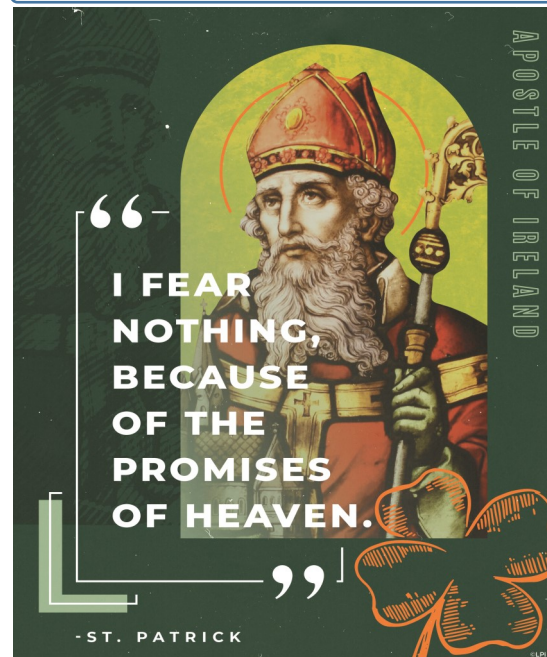

THANK YOU FOR YOUR GENEROSITY

Sincere thanks to all who contribute so generously and regularly to our parish collections. Your support is very much appreciated. The two collections during Mass (as well as the Christmas, Easter and Summer dues) go to the central administration of the diocese.

The money given in the First Collection and in the dues is used to pay the salaries of the priests working in parishes as well as those who are sick and retired. The proceeds of the second collection (Share) pays for the services provided by the diocese (e.g. Education, Finance, Safeguarding, Mission and Ministry) and is also used to support parishes that are struggling financially.

If you want to support the parish at local level, you can use the weekly envelopes or pay by standing order (details in parish office). This money pays for the upkeep of the church, wages, altar supplies, heat and light etc. There is also the option of the Tap and Go machines at the church door. If your recorded donations for a given year exceed €250, the parish can benefit from the Tax Back scheme at no extra cost to you.
