### THANK YOU FOR YOUR GENEROSITY

Sincere thanks to all who contribute so generously and regularly to our parish collections. Your support is very much appreciated. The two collections during Mass (as well as the Christmas, Easter and Summer dues) go to the central administration of the diocese. The money given in the First Collection and in the dues is used to pay the salaries of the priests working in parishes as well as those who are sick and retired. The proceeds of the second collection (Share) pays for the services provided by the diocese (e.g. Education, Finance, Safeguarding, Mission and Ministry) and is also used to support parishes that are struggling financially.

If you want to support the parish at local level, you can use the weekly envelopes or pay by standing order (details in parish office). This money pays for the upkeep of the church, wages, altar supplies, heat and light etc. There is also the option of the Tap and Go machines at the church door. If your recorded donations for a given year exceed €250, the parish can benefit from the Tax Back scheme at no extra cost to you. ### As we begin Holy Week .....

Today is Palm Sunday (or Passion Sunday). It is not just another Sunday – the 'Sunday of the Long Gospel'. It is the beginning of a week of commemoration of the last week in the earthly life of Jesus. We call it Holy Week and it forms a single unit, from entry into Jerusalem, through crucifixion and death, and culminating with the resurrection which we celebrate next Sunday.. It is a dramatic re-enactment which takes in:

- The triumphal entry into Jerusalem – palm branches to welcome the King.
- Final days – as the 'clouds gather' and there is talk of betrayal and death.
- The Last Supper – institution of the Eucharist
- Agony in the garden, arrest and trial
- Shame and torture of the crucifixion and death of the sinless one
- Desolation and emptiness of Holy Saturday
- The Easter Vigil: announcing the Resurrection
- New life – new hope & joy of Easter Sunday

All together form a unit, not just individual commemorations of different events. It would be great if we could make a special effort to attend all of the major celebrations of this Holy Week.
