Prior to working freelance, Gráinne was part of the Theology department in All Hallows College (Dublin) for many years, while also working in pastoral lead-



ership at both parish and diocesan level. Her Veritas publication "Joy of Love: A Family Perspective", is a book of spiritual reflections and prayers which situates the writings of Pope Francis in the reality of family experience today. The subject of her doctoral research was exploring the faith stories of women in the Irish Catholic church. Dr. Gráinne Doherty comes highly recommended.
