


St Brigid's Parish Cabinteely

The season of Lent is 40 days connecting us with Jesus Himself. We begin being marked with the sign of the cross on our foreheads on Ash Wednesday, March 5<sup>th</sup>. This has a link with the end of Lent when Jesus died on the cross for love of us. The sign on the forehead is not seen by ourselves but by those who see us. It is a visible witness that we are beginning and undertaking something. That something is our response to Jesus' invitation to us to enter into a closer union with him, who suffered and died for our sins.

It's hard for us to get closer to God unless we make space in our hearts for him. During lent there are our own individual opportunities. The parish, in addition to our normal schedule, will offer a Holy Hour each Thursday evening beginning at 7.30pm.
